Students' return to school - January 2021

Following the announcement from the Secretary of State, I write to confirm our plans for the start of the new term.

There has been lots of information from the Department for Education released in a short period and it has also changed several times. This, however, is our current provision for students in different year groups. Please take time to read it carefully.

For Vulnerable Students and the children of Critical Workers

- The school will be open for all children in these categories from Tuesday 5 January.
- If your child has previously attended school as an identified vulnerable learner or both parents are critical workers, they will be expected to attend school. If you believe your child is in this category and will be attending school, please let the school know so that we can plan accordingly by emailing welfare@holderness.academy with your child's name and year group no later than 11am on Monday 4 January 2021. We will then confirm your child's place by 4pm on Monday 4 January.
- These students will work in year group bubbles accessing the same work as other students in their year group who are working from home; they will not be taught face to face.

For Students in Year 11
