

## Dear Parent/Carer

The Consortium Academy Trust (TCAT) is actively monitoring the situation around the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and following the advice given by Public Health England and specific advice provided for schools by the Department for Education. Each academy within the Trust has specific procedures in place to follow this guidance and at Holderness Academy and Sixth Form College this is as follows:

I would like to provide you with an update on our plans and preparations for any potential disruption to the academy which may occur as a result of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. As you will be aware from the significant media coverage, the information and advice relating to the Coronavirus is changing daily and I want to reassure you that we are closely monitoring the updates that we receive from Public Health England (PHE) and the Department for Education (DfE) and we continue to follow their advice fully.

# Promoting good personal hygiene

At present, we are promoting good personal hygiene, particularly the importance of regular hand washing for all students, staff and visitors to the academy. To support this, we have placed posters promoting good hand hygiene in key areas, including all toilets, and ensured that we have a plentiful stock of hand wash available. We have affixed dispensers, containing antibacterial hand sanitiser, at our main entrance/exit points.
