As we approach the final week of this half term, I am keen to provide you with some key dates of forthcoming events.

### Year 11 Centre Assessed Examinations (CAEs) - commencing Monday 5th February

These examinations will take place over two weeks, from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February until Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2024, and from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February until Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February. Timetables for exams can be found on your Arbor parent portal.

CAEs provide opportunity for our Year 11 students to sit exams in a formal environment and are a good rehearsal for the final GCSE exams this summer.

The CAEs will enable students to better understand how to work effectively in timed exam conditions and will also provide teachers with a clear indication of where students may need additional support to be able to achieve their full potential during the summer 2024 exam period. It is therefore important for students to do their very best, not only so that they can see the progress that they are making, but also to get feedback on what they need to work on to achieve the results they deserve.

# Year 9 Pathways (options) evening - Thursday 8th February 3.30pm - 5.30pm

This event provides both parents/carers and students the opportunity to learn about the different GCSE subjects offered at Holderness Academy & Sixth Form College, and to ask any questions. Year 9 students will also be able to gain further information about Post 16 Options from our Careers Fair.
