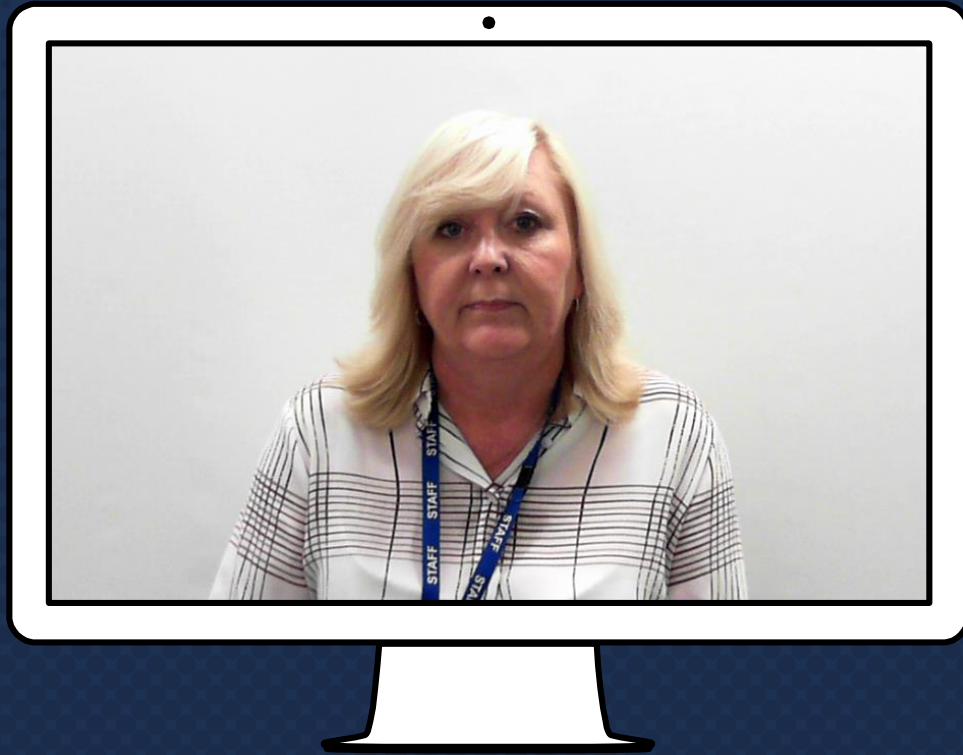


# Can I use my mobile in school?

If you are not well enough to attend school, your Parents/Carers should ring the school before 9:30am to advise us on 01482 899315.


Attendance is vital to academic learning and progression.
