Data Allowances for Mobile Phone Users

Apologies for contacting you again this week, but I wanted to make you aware that the Department for Education (DfE) has a scheme which temporarily increases data allowances for mobile phone users on certain networks and therefore, further support students with their home learning.

We can, on your behalf, request mobile data increases for children and young people who:

- do not have fixed broadband at home
- cannot afford additional data for their devices
- are experiencing disruption to their face-to-face education

Children with access to a mobile phone on one of the following networks might be able to benefit (Three, Smarty, Virgin Mobile, EE, Tesco Mobile, Sky Mobile and O2). Other providers may join the scheme at a later stage.
