Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

Change of Caterers

As part of the Trust's wider procurement strategy, the contract for Trust-wide school catering was put out for competitive tender earlier this year and this contract was won by ABM Caterers. We are very excited to be working with a new provider and keen to see how the students engage with their plans to broaden the range of food available in school. ABM Caterers will work within our existing payment system so students can continue to make cashless purchases. Further information, including menu options, will be available on our website shortly.

School Uniform

Our main uniform provider, Rawcliffes, is reporting steady business at the moment as parents make purchases of uniform for the new school year. We strongly urge parents not to leave this too late in the summer as Rawcliffes are always very busy in the final weeks of the holiday.

School Buses

We have been made aware of some minor changes to the East Riding Bus services which serve our academy – our website has been updated to reflect these changes, and up to date information from ERYC can be found here.
