A Level Results Day

Due to the challenges of lockdown and the constant changes this creates, we are planning for a slightly different type of A Level Results Day this year.

All Year 13 students will receive their results on 13 August at the exact same time. However, you will also be able to collect your results from the Sixth Form if you wish to do so. This will allow those staff present on the day to offer their congratulations and provide any support and guidance for the next stage of your career. To provide this opportunity we will still need to follow strict guidelines, the key areas being:

- If you have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have someone in your household who does, please do not attend school.
- Please maintain social distancing at all times and do not gather at school entrances or doors.

The order of the day will begin at 8.30am when A level/BTEC results will be sent via email to your student email address. This is in order to comply with GDPR. If your parents wish to receive a copy of your results, it will be down to you to inform the exams office exams@holderness.academy that you provide permission to do so. An email needs to be sent from your student account to the exams office outlining that "I give my permission for my parent [insert name] to also receive the email containing my examination results. Please can you send that email to [insert parent email address]"

For any student coming in to the Sixth Form to collect their results, your parent will need to book a time slot through this link, which will be live from Monday 27 July: https://holdernessacademy.schoolcloud.co.uk/

This does mean that time slots are limited to 10 minute blocks to support social distancing and prevent overcrowding. You can collect your results from the Sixth Form Study Area by following the one-way-system from the entrance. Staff will be on hand to guide you round and answer any questions you may have.

Please note that parents are welcome to accompany you to the site, but we do ask that only you enter the building to prevent any mixing and aid social distancing measures.

Where there are any UCAS concerns or queries, staff will try to address these in the time slot that you have. If more support or time is needed the opportunity of another appointment will be offered and scheduled. We will make sure that you have all of our support in getting to where you want to be – even if the situation is slightly different to previous results days. Rest assured or goal is to support you in moving forward and keep you safe!
